GETTING TO THE ZOO

ARRIVING AT WILD LIGHTS

ARRIVING AT WILD LIGHTS



You will enter into the Wild Lights at Dublin Zoo here.

A member of staff will need to scan your tickets in order for you to gain entry into Wild Lights.





When you enter Wild Lights, there will be a large lantern display featuring Charles Darwin and the tree of life.


There will also be a large map which will help you plan your route around 'A Journey Through Time'.





Throughout the Zoo, there will also be maps like this, helping you plan your route around 'A Journey Through Time'.








A sensory friendly map has also been created for Wild Lights. This will be emailed to all visitors and is also available online.



You will see lots of different lanterns!





Nearly all of the animals at Dublin Zoo will be in bed with the curtains over their windows, so it is very unlikely you will see any animals.

But, if you're lucky, you might hear some noises like the lions roaring or the sea lions barking as you walk past their habitats.





There will be music playing from speakers as you explore 'A Journey Through Time'.

There are also some lanterns that move.

If the lights or noise bother or upset you, you can let your group know and move to another area.





If you need a bathroom break, you can ask your group to look for the toilet icon on the blue signs to show the nearest toilet. You might hear some loud noises from the hand dryers.

There is also a Changing Places facility beside the Discovery and Learning Centre.





If you need a break from the event, you can ask to go to one of our zoothing rooms, which are indicated on the Wild Lights map and onsite at the Zoo by the signs above.

A zoothing room is a quiet space that can help you feel calm. These are located in the Meerkat Restaurant and Discovery & Learning Theatre.





If you get hungry, there will be lots of places for you to get some food, such as hotdogs and burgers from WUFF and snacks from the Picnic Bench or the vending machines.





There will be stalls selling toys and Christmas gifts as you explore 'A Journey Through Time'.





You will pass the playgrounds throughout the Zoo, but they will be closed.

You can visit the playgrounds the next time you visit

Dublin Zoo during the day!





Before you leave, you can visit the gift shop where there are lots of different toys and gifts on sale.

You may need to wait in line to purchase any items, which may take some time.

The shop may be noisy and crowded.
